


My Home

To do so, click the **Home Transfer** button, opening the screen below.




Let's use an example to see how this works...

EXAMPLE: Your current Home is *KTIW | Tacoma Narrows Airport*. You want to transfer to *KBOS | Boston Logan International Airport*.

In the **Home: Text Box**, enter **KBOS**.

Click the box beside '*I want my flight location to be my new home.*'

Afterwards, your screen will look like the one below.




The **Total Cost** of the **Home Transfer** is the amount indicated.

*If the Total Cost is **greater than** the amount of money in the Wallet, the Hub Transfer can't be completed. In this case, that's **not** a problem because the Wallet balance **exceeds** the Total Cost of the Hub Transfer.*

Online ATC Networks



Social Networks


